







STATEMENT REACH REGULATION (EC) 1907/2006 ACCORDING THE SVHC CANDIDATE LIST

Dear Sir or Madam

According to Article 33 (1) of the REACH Regulation, all substances of very high concern (SVHC) according to the current candidate list (https://echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table), which are present in concentrations above 0.1 % w/w, must be identified in section 15.1 of the material safety data sheet (MSDS) of the following product groups of Bada AG

BADAMID® / BADATECH HT® / BADAFLEX® / BADATRON® / BADAPRENE® / BADADUR® / BADALAC® / BADAFORM® / BADALON® / BADADROP® / BADAGREEN®

Every customer in the EU will automatically receive the updated material safety data sheet from us if they have been supplied with a product containing a SVHC substance within the last 12 months.

The SVHC candidate list is usually updated every six months. However, there is no legal obligation to update the MSDS every six months if no significant changes in content have occurred.

Annex XVII of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) lists the substances whose manufacture, placing on the market or use is restricted or prohibited in the European Union. Information on Annex XVII and on SVHC substances already included in Annex XIV (Authorisation List) of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) can be found in section 15 of the respective MSDS.
